

**Cross Cultural Covenant Community
Student Opportunity Scholarship
Application for 2017-2018**

The Student Opportunity Scholarship, administered by the Cross Cultural Covenant Community (CCCC) of the Presbytery of Denver, assists students by providing partial aid for books, tuition or other approved expenses for a post-secondary educational program. This scholarship is extended to students in the Cross Cultural Covenant Community's member churches to help those who might otherwise not be able to pursue post-secondary education.

Eligibility Requirements

The student must

- Be active in one of the CCCC churches
- Be accepted as a full-time student at an accredited college, university, or technical/vocational school in the United States
- Demonstrate financial need
- Maintain a 2.5 cumulative GPA on a 4.0 scale
- Demonstrate personal qualities of character and leadership as reflected in participation in church, school, and community

Range of award

Up to \$1,000, with flexibility depending on availability of funds

In Order to Apply the Student Must

Submit the following:

- Completed application form
- Parents' or responsible party's financial statement
- An essay on an assigned topic
- Letter of recommendation from the student's pastor
- Transcript of grades from current or most recent school

renewal

Annually, contingent on meeting all requirements and on availability of funds

Our process:

CCCC Student Opportunity Scholarship uses the following selection process:

1. After the completed application is submitted a sub-committee of the Cross Cultural Covenant Community will review the application and determine if the student meets the eligibility requirements for the scholarship. If the student does not meet the requirements the sub-committee will notify the student in writing of the reason for the denial.

2. The sub-committee will meet to consider all eligible applicants, conduct interviews, and award scholarships.

3. Students will be notified if they are selected for a scholarship, and the amount of the award.
